Covid mitigation and protocol revision; updated by Council March 8, 2022

Monroe County Covid 7-day rolling new case rate is less than 100/100k residents and new hospital admissions are less than a total of 10/100 residents per week

- b) Physical distancing restrictions are relaxed, but physical distancing is encouraged.
- c) Other mitigations, protocols and screening practices remain in place.
- d) Communion will continue with use of packets.
- e) Sharing of the Peace will remain without physical contact.
- f) Choir singing is allowed.
