A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR JOSH...

With the coming of Ash Wednesday, the Church enters the holy season of Lent. These forty days call us again to walk with our Lord toward the cross, to hear His Word with renewed attentiveness, and to remember both who we are and whose we are.


Lent begins with a sobering truth: "You are dust, and to dust you shall return." These words remind us of our mortality and of the seriousness of sin. Lent does not shy away from the Law's clear diagnosis of our condition. We confess that we have sinned in thought, word, and deed, and that we cannot save ourselves. Yet Lent never leaves us there.

This year we will be using sanctified art for the season of Lent. The theme this year is "Tell me something good." Even as we sit in the somberness of Lent, we will be reminded each week we will be reminded that each time we gather we center ourselves around the Gospel, which is literally translated for the Greek the 'good news' of Jesus.

As you observe this season, I encourage you to make space for God's Word—whether through worship, devotional reading, or quiet prayer. Consider how Christ's self-giving love shapes your daily vocations and how you might reflect that love in service to others. Even small acts, done in faith, are holy in God's sight. Live the good news.

May this Lenten journey lead us again to the foot of the cross, where we find not condemnation, but mercy; not despair, but hope. And may the Holy Spirit keep us steadfast in faith until we rejoice together in the resurrection of our Lord.







LuMin is a ministry of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America inviting all students from the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, Western Technical College, and Viterbo University on a journey of faith together! We are supported by the congregations of the La Crosse Area Synod and the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, as well as gifts from individuals who have a heart for ministry with college students. Pastor Kathryn Thompson is the Lutheran Campus Pastor for LuMin.

LuMin La Crosse is a place to gather in worship, connect to study, grab a cup of coffee, share a meal, sit in prayer, and meet for Bible study. 


