Offering Envelope Cost Savings Update

Myrt has removed all the names that congregation volunteered to have removed from the list receiving offering envelopes. In addition, as the Council approved, she removed the names of people who have not used the envelopes for the last 3 years.

This cost savings project successfully reduced the number of people receiving offering envelopes from 314 to 150. That's a 52% reduction. The change will be noticeable in January 2024.
