A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR JOSH...

Grace and peace to you,

February means my favorite church season of the year is quickly approaching. Valentines Day, February 14th marks Ash Wednesday this year, and the beginning of Lent. For me the forty days of Lent are some of the most meaningful days of the year.

You may be asking why Lent, a season of darkness and solemnity would be my favorite church season with so many to choose from.

Lent is a season of reflection and preparation. It is a time for us to slow down and reflect on our relationship with God and one another. Traditionally Christians have given something up as a spiritual discipline for Lent, but it is also traditional to use Lent to take on a new practice in strengthening our relationship with God.

Finally Lent is a reminder of our mortality and our need for God. A reminder that we cannot do it all on our own, and we cannot save ourselves. But a reminder also that we serve a God on whom we can lean, who was willing to lay down his own life that we might live. Many Christians wish to rush through Lent to Easter, but I am reminded that without Lent and Holy Week there is no Easter.

I encourage you to live in the slowness, intentionality, and sorrow of Lent so that the Joy of Easter might be all the greater having pondered our need for resurrection.

What are you giving up or taking on this Lent?

I will be once more studying daily Walt Wangerin Jr.'s devotional "Reliving the Passion," as he daily reflects on Jesus' journey to the cross in Mark. If you are looking for a Lenten practice, I would highly recommend this book as a way to daily connect with scripture in this season.

Blessings to you as we embark on this journey through Lent together.

During the next few months, leading up to our service and celebration at Norskedalen in August, we will be sharing information about the Fund for Leaders and asking for contributions to this gift for the church.





MISSION ENDOWMENT FUND UPDATE



Are you still working on your New Year's resolution? According to a recent CNN report, about 40% of us set one or more New Year's resolutions and nearly half of us will be successful in 6 months. Keys to success: make it specific, make it possible, make it meaningful.

- * <u>Beneficiary designation</u>: Name (congregation/endowment fund name) as a % beneficiary of your retirement account or insurance policy.
- * Qualified Charitable Distribution from an IRA: Consider a Charitable IRA Rollover which may provide a mechanism for transferring your annual Required Minimum Distribution to charitable organizations. The SECURE Act, signed into law on December 20, 2019, brings some changes to giving through an IRA. - * <u>Life Income Agreements</u>: Charitable Gift Annuities and Charitable Remainder Trusts can be wonderful solutions for donors who wish to support their church and or other ministries in a substantial way but are concerned about having resources they need in retirement. Benefits may include payments for life, possible tax benefits, and remainder gift to charity.
- * <u>Cash, appreciated securities or real estate</u> may allow you to make an impact on the ministry of our church today.

A planned gift may enable you to make a more significant gift to Trinity Lutheran than you ever thought possible while at the same time advancing your financial and estate planning goals. The ELCA Foundation can help you choose the option that is right for you and the ministries you wish to support.
